 - ii. Joint Publications

 - ii. The implementation of any and all exchange programs will be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions by the way of separate agreement and subject to applicable UGC Regulation/s.

- iii. Participation in the exchange program will continue as long as both institutions deem the experience mutually beneficial. It is the intent and desire of both institutions to continue to develop inter-disciplinary knowledge relations and intellectual growth through the exchange of people and ideas.



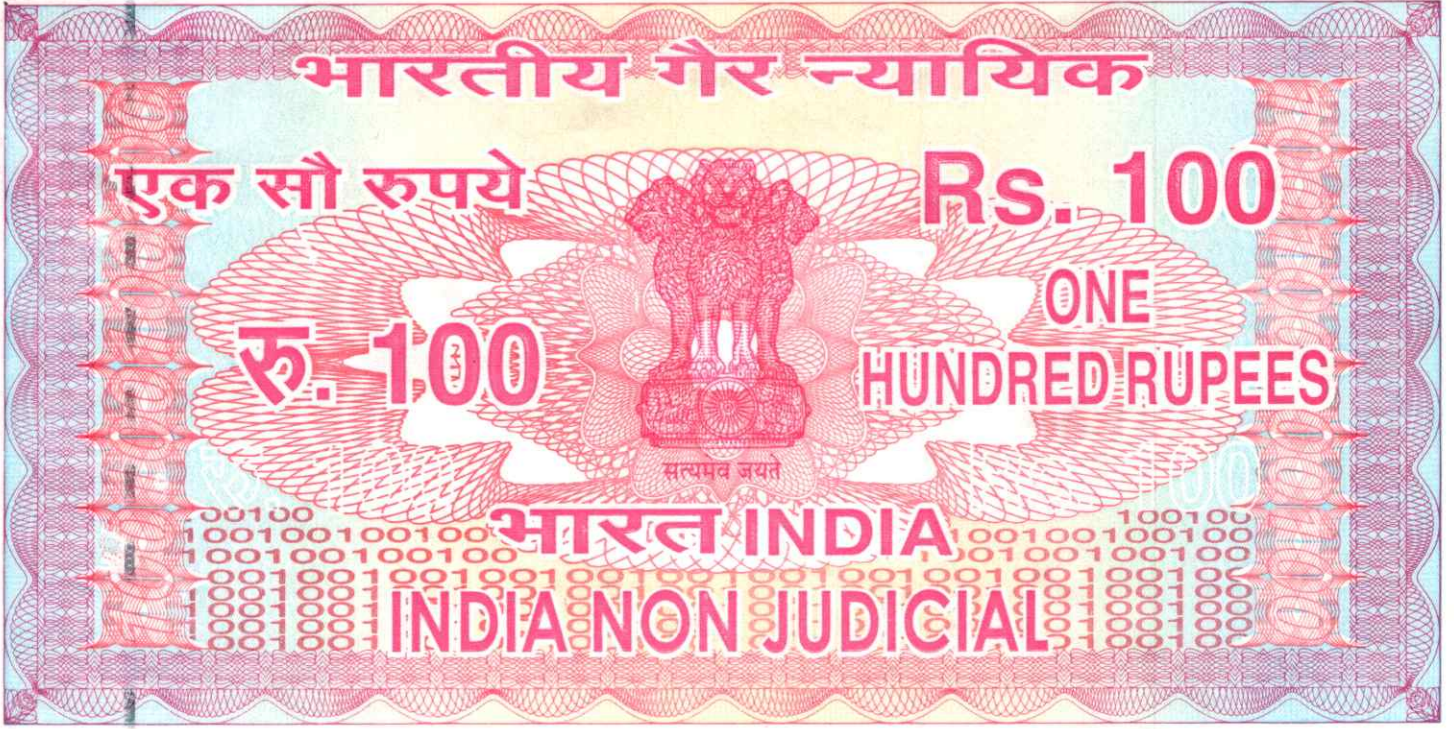



4. This agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with Indian law.



REPORT

Recent developments in molecular biology techniques have introduced a new dimension to the medical research laboratory and clinical diagnosis laboratory. It is very important for clinical and non-clinical medical professionals to gain fundamental knowledge of molecular biology techniques. In view of the increasing importance of molecular techniques in clinical application, the PG & Research Department of Microbiology, VICAS was signed MoU with OPRL Biosciences Pvt. Ltd Chennai and organized one day workshop in DNA fingerprinting using RFLP, during 24th December, 2019. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. B.T. Sureshkumar (Principal, VICAS) with a brief introduction of the workshop.

Our chief guest Mr. A. Saravanakumar, Director, OPRL Biosciences Pvt. Ltd, delivered lecture on application of molecular techniques in clinical and non-clinical fields. Followed by the workshop with enthusiastic involvement of students. RFLP analysis relies on digestion of DNA samples with restriction enzymes. Differences arise between individuals in sizes of corresponding fragments, resulting from sequence differences at DNA restriction sites or within restriction fragments. The fragments are then separated by agarose gel electrophoresis, which generates a characteristic smear pattern owing to the continuous distribution of fragment sizes. DNA is transferred from the gel and fixed on a solid membrane, and band polymorphism is visualized, after hybridization of a labeled probe to homologous sequences on the separated fragments, by detection of hybridization sites. Thus, a set of probe-specific bands is produced from the smear of DNA fragments. Different types of probe allow investigation of varying numbers of bands and different degrees of polymorphism. The session end with the vote of thanks delivered by Dr. T. Shankar, Dean, Department of Microbiology, VICAS and followed by National anthem.

Through this workshop programme the students understood the working principle of RFLP, each and every step in RFLP. During the workshop programme student interact with expert and clear their doubts.

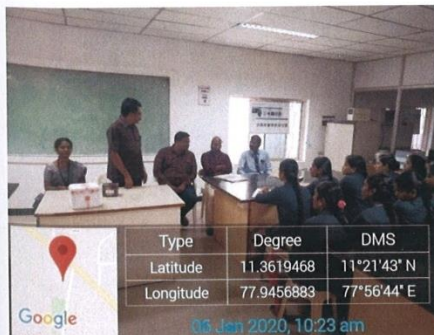
